DEAR YWCA FRIENDS,

As we celebrate a year of growth, innovation, and the successes of thousands of victims who took steps towards healing, **we celebrate with you**. Each of the 5,600 people we served this past year is someone's friend, daughter, or loved one. To each, the YW was able to offer hope, healing, and renewal, thanks to your generosity.

In support of our continued work with the Individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Task Force that we established in 2011 – the first of its kind in Michigan – the YWCA was **awarded an Office of Violence Against Women (Dept. of Justice) grant** for training and enhanced services to help serve this population, one that is up to ten times more likely to be victimized. .

In April, the YWCA **opened the state's first satellite office of our Nurse Examiner Program (NEP)** in partnership with Spectrum Health United Hospital and Relief After Violent Encounter – Ionia/ Montcalm, Inc. (RAVE). Located in Greenville, the office provides sexual assault victims in Ionia and Montcalm counties with a more sensitive alternative to a traditional emergency department and the geographic proximity that ensures immediate access.

Yet, the NEP's growth didn't stop there. With all NEP nursing staff trained to provide medical-forensic examinations to children under 13 years old, the NEP successfully ended its pilot period and **expanded its service to seven days a week for the youngest of its patients**.

With an eye to the future and based on the very positive response from the YWCA Feasibility Study, the Board of Directors unanimously voted to **undertake a \$6.2 million fundraising effort** in order to address critical infrastructure issues with our Sheldon and College facilities, continue our new work to improve our community's response to the sexual assault of individuals with disabilities, and significantly bolster the YWCA's financial resources for the short- and long-term health of the organization.

This is a momentous time for the YWCA and one that holds great promise for this organization's continued growth. In no small measure, it is one that your support and partnership has brightened.

PROGRAM SERVICE REPORT

With comprehensive services, participation in community-based solutions, and ongoing education, our vision is a community that demonstrates a commitment to creating a nurturing, violence-free environment for women and children.

self defense and violence prevention; adolescent pregnancy prevention; media and economic literacy; resisting pressure to use harmful drugs; leadership development; increase self-confidence in science, math, technology, and related careers

676 girls served in classroom and after-school programs

92 percent of participants increased developmental assets that focus on commitment to learning, social competencies, positive identity, boundaries and expectations, support, and empowerment.

100 percent of participants identify themselves as “of value” as opposed to “at risk.”

92 percent of participants developed personal safety plans.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

emergency shelter; long-term supportive housing; advocacy

396 victims (169 families) served at the Domestic Crisis Center/Sojourner House, our domestic violence emergency residence

319 victims (104 families) served in Project HEAL, our long-term supportive housing program

72 percent of Project HEAL participants transitioned into safe permanent housing.

46 percent of families leaving Sojourner House moved into a permanent residence or a transitional housing program, and 27 percent moved in temporarily with family or friends while waiting for a spot in transitional housing to open.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE NON-RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

victim counseling; assailant counseling; supervised parenting time and safe child exchange; medical-forensic examinations; advocacy

1,103 (932 families) victims/survivors served

89 percent of participants in domestic violence crisis advocacy created a safety plan, which includes reviewing their potential points of vulnerability and planning responses ahead of time to emergency situations.

98 percent of support group participants indicated that they now understand normal reactions to being assaulted, a key part of understanding and healing from the domestic violence they have encountered.

100 percent of support group participants indicated that their participation in the group was helpful in moving them forward in their journey of hope, healing, and renewal.

24-HOUR SEXUAL ASSAULT CRISIS HOTLINE (616-776-7273/RAPE)

568 individuals helped

94 percent of callers indicated that the staff member who answered the call was a helpful ally in their time of need.

93 percent of sexual assault hotline callers were given practical, immediate help by learning of one or more specific community resource available to them, including the YW's Nurse Examiner Program.

SEXUAL ASSAULT SERVICES

advocacy; individual and group therapy; short-term respite services for victims unable to return home; medical-forensic examinations

426 victims/survivors served by advocacy, therapy, and respite (for victims unable to return home)

240 victims/survivors served by our Nurse Examiner Program (adults, adolescents, and children)

93 percent of Nurse Examiner Program patients participated in safety planning with a victim advocate or nurse.

95 percent of Nurse Examiner Program patients (or their parents) received information about legal and medical support available to sexual assault victims.

CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES

Individual, family, marital, and group counseling; education groups; support groups

215 victims/survivors served

112 families of victims/survivors served

70 percent of child sexual abuse victims in therapy made significant improvements in pre- and post-therapy assessment measures, revealing they have taken important steps in recovering from the trauma of sexual assault.
